## Pregnancy (Examiner info)

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<b>History:</b>	
Introduction and patient details	
Obtains good obstetric Hx	
<b>Examination:</b>	
Obtains consent and offers chaperone	
Appropriately positions the patient and washes hands (and puts gloves on)	
Explains the procedure to the patient	
Inspects Abdo wall	
Measures Fundal Height and checks this against expected value.	
Palpates the foetus and correctly identifies the lie, presentation and position of the foetus.	
Auscultate the foetal heart rate and records this	
Obtains and records mother's blood pressure
